Topic: The Viking and Anglo-Saxon Struggle for England

This plan is to give you an insight into the topics your child will be covering this term- it's not intended as extra homework, just a prompt for some discussions you might want to have at home.



English	<p>Writing: Independent pieces across a range of genre and form.</p> <p>Text: Cogheart by Peter Bunzl and Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo.</p> <p>Spelling, Grammar, Punctuation: Reinforce and develop in school and at home.</p> <p>Reading: across a range of literature in school and at home; both fiction and non-fiction and a variety of genre.</p>
Maths	<p>Areas of Learning:</p> <p>Multiplication and Division</p> <p>Fractions</p> <p>Decimals and Percentages</p> <p>Perimeter and Area</p> <p>Statistics</p>
Science	<p>Space; Children will learn how the earth and moon move, learn about different planets in the solar system and understand night and day by explaining the rotation of the earth on its axis.</p> <p>Climate change – children will learn about climate change and how it affects our world and the positive actions we can make to better the planet.</p>
Computing	Children will develop further their understanding of E-safety, word processing and touch typing skills through a range of programs.
Art & Design Technology	<p>Art & DT; Investigating and creating art compositions based upon classical artists. Designing and creating items used and worn by the Vikings using a variety of media.</p> <p>Creating models of the solar system.</p>
History/Geography	<p>History: Vikings and the later Anglo-Saxons.</p> <p>Geography: Investigate using maps, atlases and online study, the physical and human geography of countries in Europe and the wider world, including their major cities, hemispheres, equator and climates.</p>
PE/Games Physical Education	PE/ Games: Play competitive games e.g. Netball, Rounders & Athletics (running, throwing, catching, agility, coordination, attack and defence).
Music	Throughout the term, children will increase knowledge of pulse, pitch, rhythm and tempo through studying and listening to music.
RE	To explore the meaning of faith. To explore the concept of God and associated celebrations across a variety of religions.
PSHE Personal, Social and Health Education.	Pupils will consider and discuss what decisions people make with money. We shall consider relationships with friends and family and keeping safe with friends and in the local environment.
