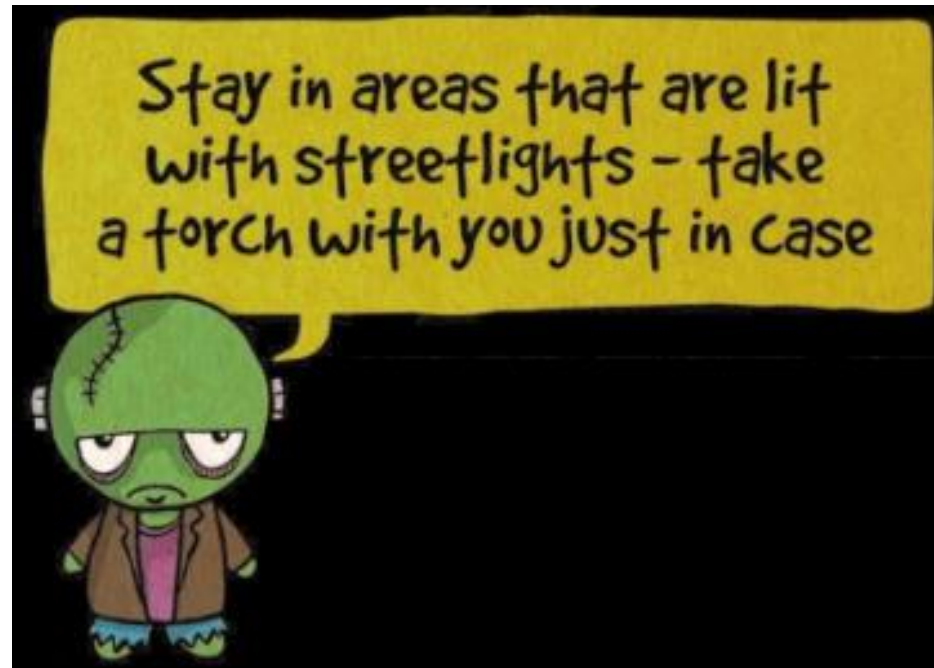

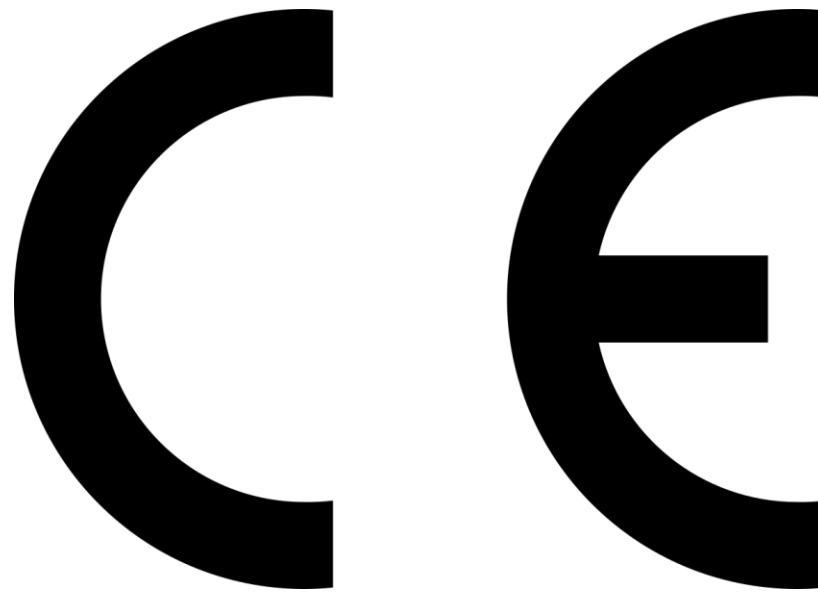

Examples of the Firework Code

- Follow the instructions on each firework.
 - Stand well back.
- Never go back to a lit firework
- Always keep the lid to the fireworks closed.
 - Keep pets indoors

Sparklers

- Sparklers burn at 2,000 degrees.
- Protect your hands by always wearing gloves.
- Clear a space around you and stand still.
- Hold Sparklers at Arms length.
- When Sparkler has finished put it in cold water.
- Never pick up a dropped Sparkler – it stays hot after it goes out.
