Monday 23rd September	<p>Words ending in 'cious';</p> <p>e.g. vice, vicious, space, spacious, malice, malicious, grace, gracious, ferocity, ferocious, suspect, suspicious.</p>		
Monday 30th September	<p>Words ending in 'tious';</p> <p>e.g. ambition, ambitious, caution, cautious, fiction, fictitious, infection, infectious, nutrition, nutritious.</p>		
Monday 7th October	<p>Words ending in 'cial';</p> <p>e.g. social, special, official, artificial, superficial, financial, commercial, beneficial, crucial, prejudicial.</p>		
Monday 14th October	<p>Words ending in 'tial';</p> <p>e.g. initial, potential, essential, partial, confidential, residential, influential, impartial, palatial, torrential.</p>		
Monday 21st October	<p>Words ending in 'ant' and 'ance';</p> <p>e.g. infant, infancy, observant, observance, hesitant, hesitancy, important, importance, distant, distance.</p>
