<b>Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September</b>	Revision from previous years; e.g. mystery, syllable, touchable, could, country, disappear. Incorrect, misunderstand, illegible, irresponsible.		
<b>Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September</b>	Revision from previous years;  e.g. superhuman, international, anti-climax, information, education, properly, shortly, treasure, picture, adventure.		
<b>Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September</b>	Words ending in 'cious';  e.g. vice, vicious, space, spacious, malice, malicious, grace, gracious, ferocity, ferocious, suspect, suspicious.		
<b>Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September</b>	Words ending in 'tious';  e.g. ambition, ambitious, caution, cautious, fiction, fictitious, infection, infectious, nutrition, nutritious.		
<b>Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October</b>	Words ending in 'cial'; e.g. social, special, official, artificial, superficial, financial, commercial, beneficial, crucial, prejudicial.		
<b>Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October</b>	Words ending in 'tial'; e.g. initial, potential, essential, partial, confidential, residential, influential, impartial, palatial, torrential.		
<b>Monday 21<sup>st</sup> October</b>	Words ending in 'ant' and 'ance'; e.g. infant, infancy, observant, observance, hesitant, hesitancy, important, importance, distant, distance.
