

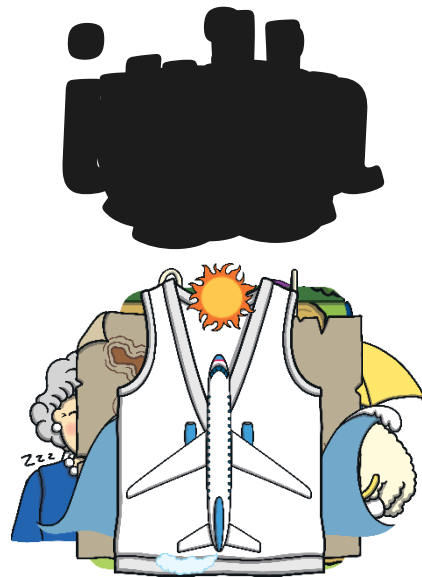

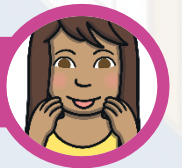
Sing the Alphabet

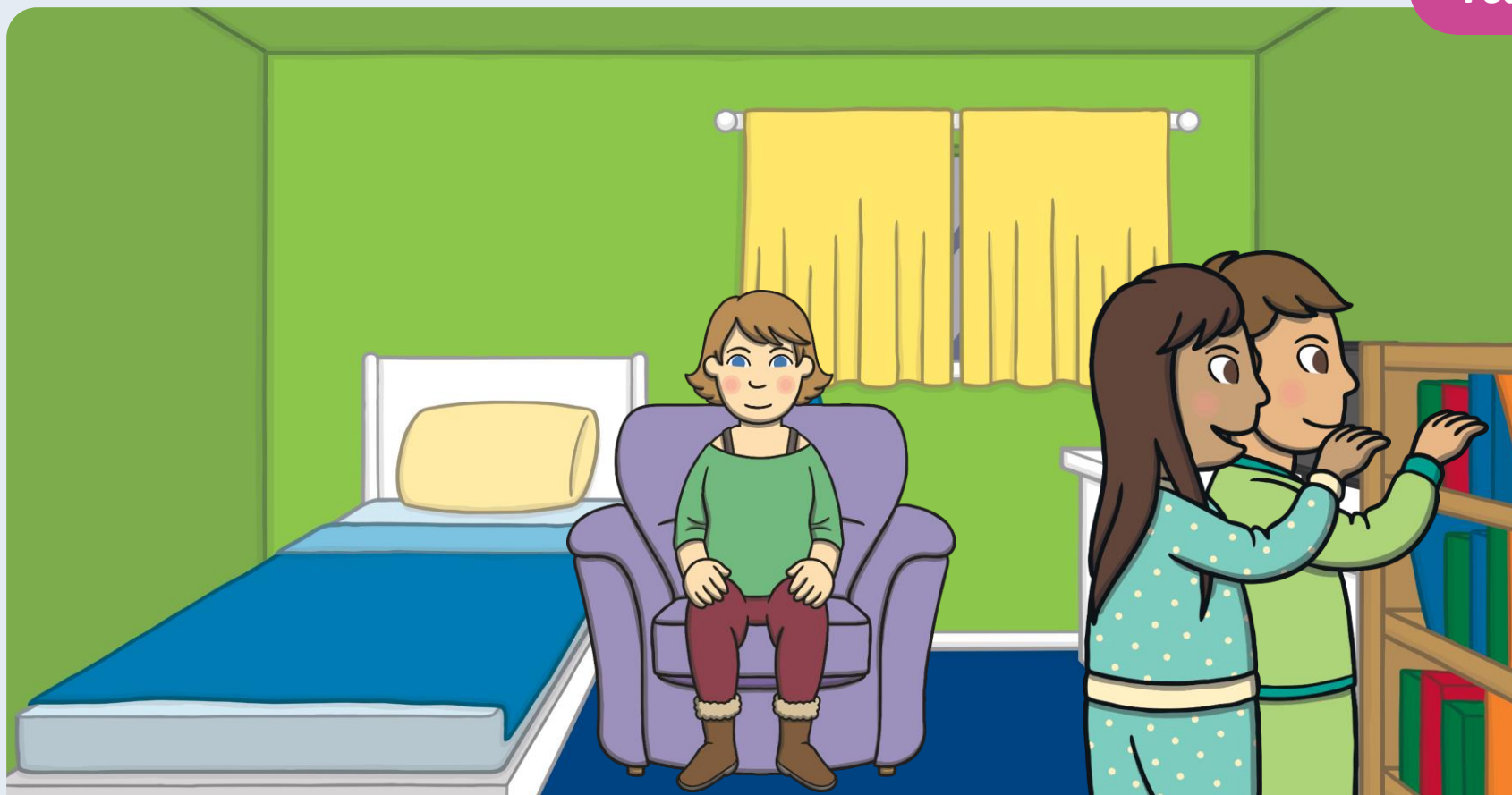
Can you sing this alphabet song along with Kit?

“Yes, let’s have this one,” said Kit.



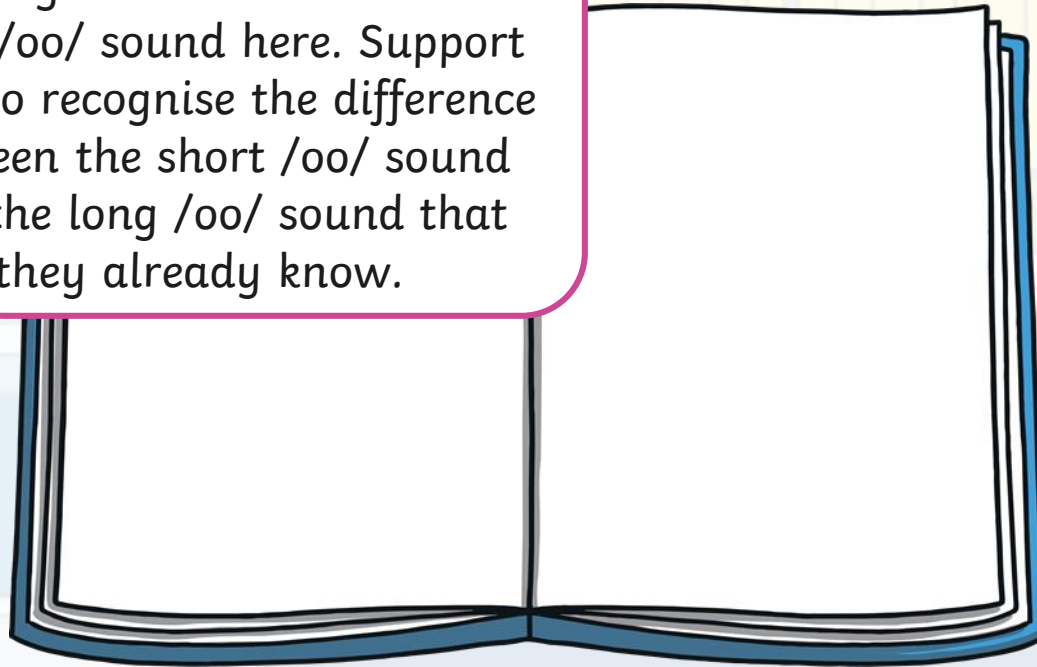
Mum opened the book and the children snuggled up tight, ready for the story. "I can't wait to see what happens," said Kit.

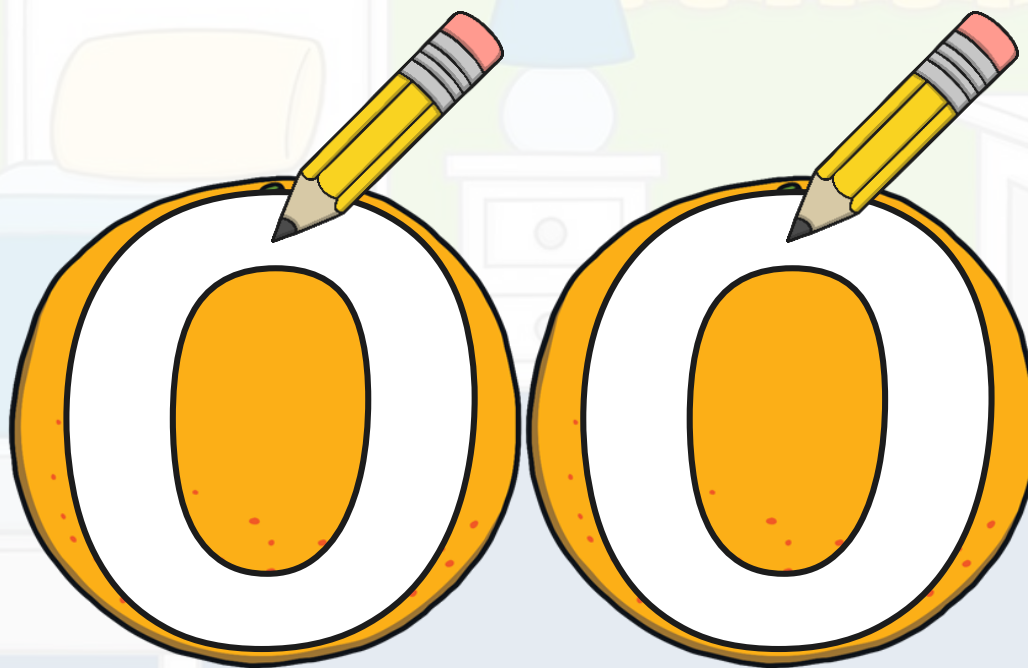
Pretend to open a book.

Around the orange and around the orange.

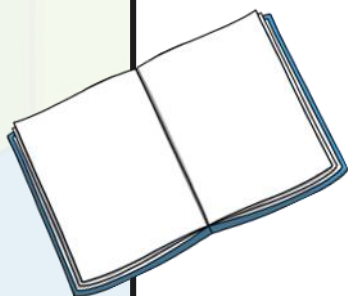

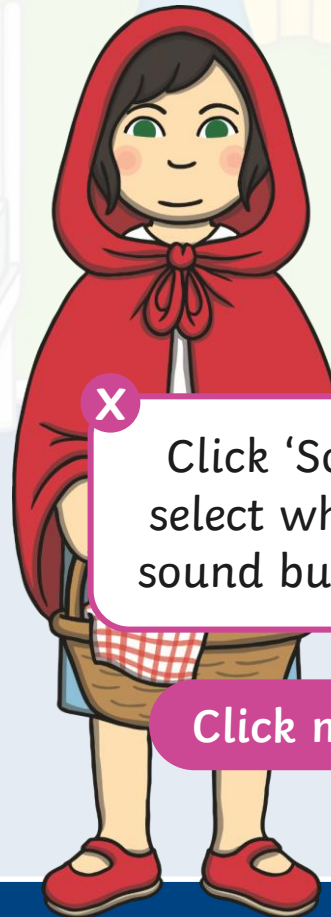




“This story is about a little girl with a red coat and hood,” said Mum as she began to read the story.

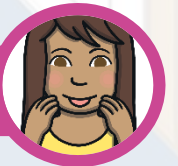
