Judas betrayed Jesus.



A crown of thorns was placed on Jesus' head.




Jesus was made to carry the cross.


Jesus died upon the cross.

Judas arrives with soldiers and the Chief Priests. Judas kissed Jesus on the cheek and called him, 'Rabbi'. Then they arrested Jesus.



Jesus was taken to Pontius Pilate then beaten and mocked. A crown of thorns was placed upon his head and everyone laughed at him.




Jesus was made to carry a heavy, wooden cross all the way to the top of a hill.


Jesus was nailed upon the cross and placed between two other prisoners. Later that day, the sky turned black and then Jesus cried out to God and died.
