This week we are going to familiarise ourselves with the story and then next week we will move on to writing it. Hansel and Gretel is a traditional tale, just like Red Riding Hood, The Gingerbread Man and The Three Little Pigs. You will need some sort of cardboard tube such as a kitchen roll tube or one of those mailing tubes that you often get in the post. You can use toilet paper rolls but you would need to stick a few together to make it longer. You then need to decorate it using Australian designs that we learnt about before half term. You could decorate it with symbols or some dot painting. You can either paint or colour directly onto the tube or you could paint your design onto a piece</p>

Traditional tales are also referred to as fairy stories or fairy tales.</p> <p>Watch this video to hear the first part of the story. Hansel and Gretel is a German traditional tale and the names of the children are common German names of the time.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DIOrPKEpf1&feature=youtu.be</p> <p>In the story, the children go on a journey through the woods, similar to the journey Little Red Riding Hood went on. The first time they went on the journey, they found their way back by following a trail of pebbles. The second time they tried to use breadcrumbs. If you are able to get out for a walk, I would like you to imagine that you are Hansel or Gretel. Maybe you can go through Belfairs Woods if you live nearby. Can you lay a trail to see if you can find your way back? You could use pebbles or small stones if you can find some but otherwise you can use some small pieces of bread. Hopefully the bread will still be there to follow your trail back as long as you don't fall asleep like Hansel and Gretel did! You can take some photos of your trail to send me or when you return you can draw a map of where you went, showing your trail of pebbles or breadcrumbs. It is set in a forest and in a gingerbread cottage. How would you feel if you found a gingerbread cottage? Would you start eating it? Discuss if Hansel and Gretel are in the wrong to eat something that doesn't belong to them. If you could build your own gingerbread cottage, what would it look like? Design your own gingerbread cottage, thinking about what sweets you would use to decorate it. You can do your design on the template in the resources or draw your own. Or if you want to be more ambitious you could try making it out of some old boxes, cardboard or lolly sticks or anything you have. Or alternatively, if you really fancy a challenge you can try to bake it out of real gingerbread.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>This term we are going to begin our topic on Plants. The term plant includes trees, flowers, bushes, weeds. Plants are around all year round but many flowers begin to bloom in the Spring. In today's lesson we are going to discuss different flowers and see which ones you already know. Begin by writing down the names of any plants you can think of, don't worry too much about the spelling, as long as you know what it says. Could you think of many?
