Enjoy your performance!</p>	<p><b>Golden Time</b> Friday afternoon is Golden Time. Spend time doing what you would like to do and enjoy yourself playing. Some ideas: *Try playing with a different toy that you haven't played with for a long time. *Play doh *Kapla/Jenga *Jigsaws &amp; puzzles *Cutting activities- many cutting skills sheets can be downloaded from the internet but drawing shapes on paper and cutting them out accurately is just as good. *Art and crafts including collage with paper scraps, tracing pictures from books at home, junk modelling with old boxes, painting, drawing, sticking, chalk numbers/letters and repeating patterns. * It is also important that they have opportunities to develop their imagination and oral story telling through role play and small world play. Give children time to set up cafes &amp; shops, build forts and dens, play with dolls, cars/trains, action figures, dinosaurs etc. *This game is also good for practising spelling of all year 1 tricky words.
