Theme: Christmas	
Monday	Follow this link and share the Christmas story you're your child https://www.topmarks.co.uk/Christmas/NativityStory.aspx
Tuesday	Watch this video about the Nativity story and discuss it with your child https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/presenters-nativity-story
Wednesday	Using the resources on the website 'nativity sequencing cards' talk about the nativity story with your child. Either print these out or look at them on the screen and ask your child to put them in the right order and retell you the story of the nativity.
Thursday	Follow this link and watch the videos https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/lets-celebrate-christmas
Friday	Look at Christmas cards around your house or use google to see pictures of them Using paper or card design your own Christmas card. Decorate it in which ever way you would like to and see if you can write the words inside yourself.

Phonics:	
Monday	<p>Watch this video https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x2wpdvv and pause the video after the song for qu.</p> <p>Follow this link https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/buried-treasure to play the game choose phase 2 +II. Ask your child to sound out each of the words and blend the sounds together to read each word. Your child must decide if each word is real or fake and drag them to the correct box.</p> <p>Cut up the words from the word sheets your child has been given so far. Stick/hide these words around the house. Can your child find these words and read them as they go?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Watch this video https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x2wpdvv and pause the video after the song for qu.</p> <p>On separate pieces of paper write out these letters (lowercase) s a t p i n m d g o c k. Use these sounds to build words by placing 3 next to each other in a line and ask your child to tell you the sounds and then read the word. EG d-o-g is dog, mat, sat, pin etc. These could be silly words as well as real words. If you would prefer you could print and cut out the phase 2 phonics flashcards from the website or use any letter flashcards you might have at home.</p> <p>Draw around your child's hand several times and cut these hand prints out and stick by your child's bedroom door. Stick some of the words</p>

	form your worksheets into the middle of the handprints. Your child must high five these words and read them every time they go into/leave their room.
Wednesday	<p>Watch this video https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x2wpdvv and pause the video after the song for qu.</p> <p>Follow this link https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/b01cz0p1/alphablocks?seriesId=b01cz0vd and choose several episode of alphablocks to watch. Using the letters that you made yesterday see if you can make some of these words and read them.</p> <p>Lay all your worksheet words face down and take turns with your child to choose one to turn over and read. If your reads it right you can keep that word.</p>
Thursday	<p>Watch this video https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x2wpdvv and pause the video after the song for qu.</p> <p>Follow this link https://www.starfall.com/h/word-machines/ and play the short vowel word machine game. Choose a vowel and then practice reading the words. Play this game as many times as your child would like with different vowels.</p> <p>Hide all the worksheet words around the house. Tell your child to find each word one at a time.</p>
Friday	<p>Watch this video https://www.dailymotion.com/video/x2wpdvv and pause the video after the song for</p> <p>Follow this link https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/b01cz0p1/alphablocks?seriesId=b01n954z and choose several episode of alphablocks to watch. Have a go at writing some of the words that you saw in the episode you chose to watch.</p> <p>Choose one of your child's books. Read the book together and see how many of their word sheet words you can find.</p>

Maths:

Counting and Number

Monday	Follow this link https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/gingerbread-man-game . Choose 'how many? - 1-10' and ask your child to count how many buttons on the gingerbread man and find the correct numeral. After several plays of this game click the menu button and select the option 'counting out – 1- 10 numbers' and play this version of the game several times.
Tuesday	<p>Have a look at your Christmas tree (if you don't have a decorated Christmas tree you could google a picture of one)</p> <p>On a sheet of paper write down all the different coloured baubles you have on your tree down one side by using words or coloured</p>

	pens/pencil. Count how many baubles of each colour you have on your Christmas tree and write the number next to each colour.
Wednesday	<p>Watch https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/m0006s5q/numberblocks-series-4-i-can-count-to-twenty</p> <p>Ask your child to count out 20 Christmas items (decorations from your tree/cards etc). Write the numbers 1-20 on separate pieces of paper. Choose a number at random and ask your child to count out that many objects.</p>
Thursday	<p>Using the numbers that you wrote yesterday, give your child the numbers 1-20 in a random order and ask them to put them in the correct order to create a number line.</p> <p>Leave the numberline on the table/floor, choose a number at random and ask your child to collect that number of Christmas items (baubles/decorations/cards etc). Ask your child to identify that number on their number line. Can they tell you what number is one more or one less than that number? Play again but choose a different number. Repeat several times with different numbers.</p>
Friday	<p>Choose a number of episodes of number blocks from this link to watch https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/b08bzfnh/numberblocks?seriesId=b0bls7vy</p> <p>Follow this link https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/teddy-numbers and play with numbers up to 15.</p>
