Use exciting adjectives from yesterday 2. Sequence the events 3. Use time words Use conjunctions</i></p> <p>Look at the drawing and adjectives you used to describe your setting yesterday. <b>Write the opening to your story</b> – this would be about 3 or 4 sentences starting with a well-known opening, eg: Once upon a time, Long ago. The opening should introduce your character and where they live. (Use <b>your sheets from Monday and Tuesday to support</b>).</p>	<p><b>Religious Education:</b></p> <p>RE</p> <p><b>LI: To understand that Muslims worship Allah. To talk about special people and leaders.</b></p> <p>Explain that every religion has a god. Either someone or something that people look up to and pray to. They are really special to that religion.</p> <p>KQ: Who do Christians pray to? (God) Who do Muslims pray to?
