Discuss the moral of the story: If you do kind deeds for others then people will be kind to you. Discuss the importance of religion in ancient Rome and the temple, even poorer people had temples and left gifts for the Gods.</p> <p>Talk about the similarities between this story and Romulus & Remus and create a list on flipchart paper:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Both have Gods• Set in Roman era• Other characters don't want to upset the Gods• Characters are disguised/not recognised• Rewards are given for good practice <p>Main Activity Due to the story being lengthy and vocabulary needing to be explained, there might not be time for a main activity.
